- Participate in fund development by taking on various tasks tailored to your comfort and skills.

An initial 3-year term beginning in September 2022; term may be renewed annually following initial term. Board members attend and participate in board meetings (7 each year), and participate in at least one standing committee, as well as the annual board planning retreat.
